

The Professional Ear Cleaning Process

Step One



You will be seated in a comfortable chair to provide a relaxing commencement to your appointment. Your ear health history is discussed with you by a Registered Nurse who is highly specialised in this procedure and the ear health field.

Step Two



A plastic funnel is placed in your ear to allow a precise view of the ear canal. The Ear Nurse Specialist places binocular glasses over the eyes, these are fitted with a bright light to allow a clear, magnified view into the ear canal.

Step Three



Then a gentle medical vacuum is used to remove the excess ear wax, or foreign objects from the ear. This will allow you to hear better and feel better.

Step Four



- We will explain the findings to you using an ear diagram.
- Let you know when and if you may need this procedure again.
- Provide information pamphlets about ear conditions.

With our highly magnified equipment, we can see microscopic particles and identify bacterial or fungal infections. To clear infections that are present, we can make recommendations for specific medicated drops which can be provided by your Doctor. We will also provide practical tips to prevent reoccurring ear infections.
