

The Professional Ear Cleaning Process



Step 1:

You will be greeted by the receptionist upon arrival and asked to fill out a form which helps assist the Nurse in providing you with a complete comprehensive assessment of your ear health. After form completion, you will be greeted by the nurse who will take you into a private room, where you will be seated for the procedure. The nurse will then discuss with you your form and previous ear history



Step 2:

A small funnel made of glass is carefully placed into your ear to provide the nurse with a complete view of your ear canal. The nurse then puts her binocular headset over her eyes, which are fitted with a bright light to allow for a clear, magnified view of your ear canal. These binoculars are specifically designed and fitted for the micro-suction process



Step 3:

After this, a gentle medical vacuum is used to remove excess ear wax, or any foreign objects situated in to ear canal



Step 4:

The nurse will give you a short summary of your ear health and her findings, she will provide you with information and pamphlets surrounding her findings. She will also provide you with a specialised management plan upon completion and discuss with you if you need to come back in for a follow up appointment

Tracy has been working as a Registered Nurse for 26 years in a variety of roles from orthopaedic trauma, to a communal child health nurse. In 2008 she decided to specialise in the ear health field, following this, Tracy performed her specialities in an Ear, Nose and Throat out-patient department for five years whilst she ran her own part-time micro-suction business in Christchurch, New Zealand. Eventually she built up the clientele to allow her business to become full-time.

Three years later, it came to her attention that this procedure was not at all common in Australia, Tracy then decided to move to the Gold Coast. Tracy's vision is to make micro-suction the primary procedure for wax removal Australia wide as it has in many other countries. New Zealand and many other countries have in fact banned water ear syringing due to the high risk of infections and ear drum perforation. Not only is Micro-suction a non-invasive procedure it is also the safest method of wax removal. The Ear Cleaning Clinic has now been running since mid-2015.
